This Scholarship is funded by an endowment from the late Mid Kolstad. Mid was a glider pilot as were her husband and her children. She became interested in flying while still in college in the 1930s. She flew with the Air Hoppers Club in New Jersey and at the Black Forest Glider Port in Colorado.

This scholarship is open to women over the age of 25 to help pay for lessons toward a Private Glider Certificate or add-on rating. Applicants must be members of WSPA and SSA or an equivalent organization if living outside the U.S. The scholarship is for \$1500 and may be used at any glider port.

Information submitted must show a commitment to soaring. Submit this form and the following items:

1. An essay of 500 words or less explaining your goals and previous experiences as they relate to gliders and how this scholarship will help you meet your goals.
2. A Photo, preferably with an aircraft – no sun glasses, please.
3. A copy of your pilot certificate (front and back).
4. A copy of your latest entry in your logbook showing your total time/flights.
5. Any other evidence that indicates you meet the requirements of this scholarship.
6. The name and address of the glider port where you plan to take your training.
